Ms.Albeena had explained about the carbohydrate content in bread and flour items and she even explained about the deficiency of carbohydrate.







Simulation based learning was conducted for III year BSc Nursing students (Group III) on 13.08.2019 at Father Muller Simulation Centre. 


CHART SHOWING THE RANGE OF NORMAL WEIGHT, UNDERWEIGHT, OVERWEIGHT AND OBESE











