 difficult to adjust time for studies. Sr Deepa suggested that instead of simply wasting
 time whatever they get if they utilize properly, that would be sufficient to complete their
 portions.
- Some parents suggested that time restrictions should be kept for mobile use or internet connection availability as some other felt there is no need to keep such restrictions. Majority commended that as they leave their children in this institution, they have a faith that this institution will help them to be disciplined and hence such rules as keeping time restrictions for mobile and internet use would make them feel more secured about their child's life.

- Meeting began with a prayer song sung by the first year B.Sc nursing students.
- Mrs Binsha Pappachan C, Chair- person of PTS committee welcomed the gathering.
- Rev. Sr Jacintha D'Souza, Principal of college of nursing gave the message to parents on the agenda. In her message principal mentioned the following issues.
 - Facilities that the institution had provided for the overall development of the students, still students' interest in studies and spiritual activities go down day by day.
 - The performance of students in both the sessional examinations are very poor as most of them have failed in more than three subjects and in another one month time they are going to appear for preparatory exam and then the final university examinations. The way most of the students are utilizing the time incollege and hostel are not effective and that is the reason their performance is not up to the mark. They go to sleep late and waking up in the morning is also late and due to that they skip their breakfast and go to class or clinicals and later they fall sick. They should develop a healthy routine and time management with which they can improve their performance.
 - Principal enquired about the need for using smartphones for students in hostel. If the
 purpose of giving phone to students is for communicating, a simple phone will do that
 purpose. As this institution if providing all facilities for students, they don't require
 phones and laptops for study purpose. If at all students are convincing parents with
 this reason, it is not correct. In fact they use phones for watching movie and spend
 time in social media which is the main distraction for them in studies. So parents

should think and decide before giving such phones to children if they really want them to perform better in examinations.

- Principal encouraged parents to support their children to develop some values in life such as honesty and discipline. Teachers expect their students to be sincere in whatever they do. Parents should never encourage children to say some lies to get an excuse to go home. They should learn to adjust to hostel especially with the food that is provided as it is cooked for many.
- Principal also mentioned about the spiritual activities going on in the campus as all
 can utilize that opportunities to develop some good habits. There are some students
 who come regularly for spiritual activities without anyone's force, hence these
 feelings and habits should be taught from home and they should feel from within, not
 by somebody's force that they will attend daily mass.
- Parents should take care not to call them frequently to home as it disturbs their
 academic programs. Any functions of parents or siblings only should be encouraged
 as it was find that they take silly reasons to go home. If at all anyone is coming down
 from abroad, it's always preferred to come here to meet the students instead of calling
 them to home which again lead to absence in clinical duty and extension duty etc.
- Rev Sr Deepa Peter took up the discussion with parents regarding any issues and problems of students. Many parents supported for not giving the smart phones to children which causes a lot of distraction fromstudies. Warden gave a small feedback about the issues related to hostel life and why few rules are kept as very strict so that the discipline of the hostel will be maintained.
- Mr Mathew, Parent member of the committee expressed his opinion about the college and hostel as they feel their children are safe in this campus and the need to encourage students to utilize the opportunities to facilities and improve the performance.
- Principal clarified the confusion prevailing regarding the INC recognition of nursing programs in Karnataka. This issue is only regarding the admission what is going on for 2017-18 academic year. All other batches have no issue and she has drafted a letter to INC regarding the same and hopes that this problem will resolve within few weeks.
- Vote of thanks was given by Mrs Swetha Rashmi, Class coordinator of First year B.Sc Nursing batch.
