





"The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Council Assessor's Report (May, 2015) and decided to recommend to the Central Government that MD(Pharmacology) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 05 seats granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at Father Muller Medical College, Mangalore be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.


